Nominations will also be considered for the award. The awards are presented every year to the winners on World Environment Day.

Each award consists of a certificate, the CEERD Trophy and a cash prize of Rs. 10000/- jointly sponsored by the former Principal Prof. V.P. Thomaskutty, the founder Chairman of CEERD, Prof. Joy Pallattumadom, the founder Executive Director of CEERD and Adv. Binoy George Cherukara, a wellwisher of CEERD and a Practicing Lawyer in the High Court of Kerala.

Selection Process

Applications for the award of Paristhithi Mithra shall reach the office of the Executive Director, CEERD, St. Stephen's College, Uzhavoor on or before 15th April along with three copies of the detailed report of the environmental activities undertaken by the organization during the previous academic year. The report shall invariably be substantiated with evidences like news paper cuttings, CDs, photographs, etc. and an undertaking by the head of the organization or the individual concerned.
