About Institution

Crowning a hillock in majestic splendour and set against a lush verdant backdrop, St. Stephen's College is the pride of Uzhavoor. The college which belongs to the Knanaya Catholic Arch Diocese of Kottayam is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University.

The brain child of the then Bishop of Kottayam, His Excellency Rev. Dr. Thomas Tharayil, the college was established in 1964. Sri. Joseph Chazhikadan ex-MLA and Rev. Fr. Peter Uralil, the first Principal of the college, were the guiding forces behind this noble Endeavour. They were supported and encouraged by the active co-operation of the people of Uzhavoor and a host of well-wishers. In the beginning, St. Stephen's was a Junior College with four batches of Pre-Degree students.

The small step taken in 1964 culminated into a giant leap by the beginning of the new millennium. In 1968 the college was upgraded to the degree level. Today it has gained in strength and size with 4 postgraduate courses, 8 undergraduate courses, a computer centre, a media centre, a network resource centre, an Astroview centre, K.R. Narayanan Study Centre, a full-fledged library and reading room, a language lab, a health and fitness centre, a big auditorium, a ladies' hostel, a well-functioning canteen, a store, spacious staff-rooms, rest rooms for students, a medicinal garden, a vermicompost unit, large grounds for sports and games, ample parking facilities and an indoor stadium.

Indeed, it makes me glad to see that St. Stephen's College has been progressing commendably in different academic spheres, over the years. NSS began this year's activities by observing Environment Day on opening day with the planting of a tree sapling on campus. A blood donation camp was next organized on 14 June 2019 in association with Kottayam Medical College where 64 units of blood were donated by the staff and students of the college. The unit-level inauguration of the university programme "വലിച്ചറിയൽമുക്തക്യാമ്പസ് ,ഗ്രാമംനഗരംപദ്ധതി " by the Principal Sri. Jose Thomas was on 17 June 2019. Second year NSS volunteers lead

The NSS and NCC units jointly celebrated International Yoga Day on 21 June by presenting a yoga demo to the whole college. A mini camp for second year NSS Volunteers was held on 22 &23June 2019 in the college campus. To observe Anti Narcotics Day, as per the directive of the Deputy Director to flag off an awareness campaign that lasts 90 days, an inter-departmental quiz competition & a talk by Fr. Dr. Mathew Kureethara (Chief Editor, APNADES) was organized on 25 & 26 June 2019 respectively. The short film "VIRAMAM" made by the NSS unit on narcotic abuse was also screened in the college auditorium.

A Tik Tok video Competition was conducted to observe Social media day (30 June 2019). Saplings were planted in and around the campus on 1 July 2019 to commemorate the 150th anniversary celebrations of Gandhiji. On 12 July 2019 vegetable

cultivation began in earnest on campus by NSS volunteers, behind the new block.

Several camps were conducted by NSS: the first was a free eye testing camp by a seven-member team in conjunction with Fathima Eye Care Hospital, Pala on 22 August 2019. An orientation Camp for First year NSS Volunteers was conducted from 24 -25 August 2019 where they had sessions on Yoga training, Paper Pen, Paper Bag, Paper cover manufacture, etc. The Special Camp "Suvarnam 2019" was held at Peruva Govt. VHSS for Girls, from 7-13 September 2019 and was attended by about 100 NSS Volunteers. Inaugurated by Mons Joseph MLA, the students were provided varied inputs by diverse resource persons on many useful topics.

On 24 September 2019, the NSS Golden Jubilee Day Rally from the College to Uzhavoor Town was flagged off by the Principal Sri. Jose Thomas. As per the directive from the Director of the College Education Department, a pledge was taken by all the staff and students in connection with Gandhi Jayanthi on 1 October 2019. On 2 October 2019, Gandhi Jayanthi was observed by the NSS & NCC units by cleaning Uzhavoor Town and K.R. Narayanan Memorial Multi-Speciality Hospital, in association with Uzhavoor Grama Panchayath. The NSS calendar was released on 31 December 2019.

As part of 'Swachta Pakhwada', on 14 December 2019 the NCC Unit organized an antiplastic rally, a flash mob, guard of honour, a public meeting at Uzhavoor Town against plastic, distribution of paper pen and paper bags made by NCC cadets, and plogging of 22kg of plastic waste from Uzhavoor Town with a no plastic message delivered by the commanding officer Col. Jose Kurian.

The NCC conducted its all Kerala NCC Fest – Commando 2020 on 18 January 2020 where there were almost 100 participants. It was at the fest that the NCC website was launched and former cadets honoured. The NCC Alumni Association was also inaugurated at this event. The NCC also conducted the 10-day NCC camp from 22 January – 1 February 2020 on campus.

The NCC had a combined Republic Day celebration with the Student Police Cadets, Scouts & Guides of OLLHSS, Uzhavoor at the school parade ground. The Republic Day message was delivered by the President of Uzhavoor Grama Panchayat Smt. Sherly Raju.

Curricular and Co-Curricular Activities

On opening day, in connection with World Environment Day, fruit trees were planted department-wise in and around the parking area. The M.Sc. students of the Physics Dept. had their project presentation on 7 June 2019. The Department of English, marked the death of Girish Karnad on 11 June 2019 by organizing a meeting in his remembrance. The Department also observed Reading Month beginning June 19 by observing Reading Day calling it "Kithabi Days" where faculty members of the department as well as the Department of Oriental Languages and the Librarian introduced various books to the students. A quiz was also organized that day as part of the celebrations.

On 24 June 2019 an orientation programme for S1 students & first year PG students was conducted by Eldo Paulose. The Department of Commerce conducted the 4th interdepartmental penalty shootout competition on 28 June 2019 with Physics Dept. emerging the winners. A Motivational talk by Vijesh M.V., Analyst of Ernst & Young and Alumni of Commerce Department, was arranged for their students on 28 June 2019.

Merit Day was held on 4 July 2019 with the chief guest being Dr. P.G. Sankaran, the Pro Vice-Chancellor of CUSAT, and prizes were distributed to the students for their academic and extra-curricular excellence in the previous academic year.

11 students secured A+ & 56 students secured A grade in the final exams, & they were awarded prizes for their achievement. 35 prizes were awarded by the various departments as part of the scholarships. The PTA awarded prizes to the top scorers for PG and UG in each department as well as for the best projects. There were also more than 20 general endowments awarded to various students, mainly for the NCC & NSS.

On 5 July 2019 a *Live Budget Analysis* for M.Com Students was conducted by Sri. CA Kurian V. John. An Orientation programme on *Insurance Awareness* by Kottayam Insurance Institute was also arranged for the other Commerce students. Sri M.V. Thomas – Vice Chairman, Sri M.J Varghese – Council Member and Smt. Latha - Secretary of the Institute lead the session.

On the same day, to commemorate the 25th death anniversary of Vaikom Mohammed Basheer the Malayalam Department conducted a quiz competition and the English Department had a *premalekhanam* competition. In addition, a book exhibition of KesavDev and Basheer was organized in this regard.

Reflections-94 was the meet up of the 1994-97 alumni batch of the Physics Dept. on 13

July 2019. Fresher's Day and all the associations' inauguration were held on 26 July 2019. A Photography competition on the topic "Nature" was organized by the Zoology Dept. on 27 July 2019 for the students.

The Commerce Department organized a 5 day Short Term course on *Data analysis & Academic Writing in Social Science* from 6 - 10 August 2019. 52 researchers and academicians from various colleges in Kerala participated in the workshop. On 19 August 2019, Dr. Stephy Thomas, Vice Principal & Assistant Professor in Statistics in BCM College, Kottayam took a class on *Data Analysis* for II M.Com students.

A State-level M.Com. project presentation competition was conducted by the Commerce Dept. on 20 August 2019 with 40 participants taking part. On 22 August 2019 CEERD distributed seeds & grow bags to its members & introduced steel glasses in the campus as part of a green initiative, in addition to beginning the *Onathinorumuram Pachakkary* Challenge. On the same day, the English Dept. invited faculty member of BCM College, kottayam Smt. Rashmi Nair and online English tutor Sri Harry C. Joseph to talk about career options. On 29 August 2019 Zero Shadow Day was observed by the Department of Physics which recreated the famous Eratosthenes experiment to measure the circumference of the Earth in collaboration with St. Pius X College, Rajapuram and Nirmalagiri College Kuthuparambu. CEERD conducted a one-day hands on skill training in glass painting &jewellery making on 31 August 2019.

A Costume day competition was conducted by the English Dept on 3 September 2019. Grow bags were prepared for vegetable cultivation by CEERD on 16 September 2019 and on 19, roof top vegetable cultivation began. A class was arranged on *Online Trading* for II B.Com students on 20 September 2019. Sri Baiju Joseph of Sharekhan Pvt. Ltd. was the resource person.

On 2 October 2019 CEERD provided training to students to produce green products with coconut leaves, paper, etc. The Commerce Dept. also had its alumni meet on that day with its former faculty members and students actively participating in the event. On 3 October 2019, a class was arranged on *Waste Management and Organic Farming* for III B.Com students by the Commerce Dept. Sri. Babu Parambath, Director & Project Coordinator, Niravu, Calicut was the resource person.

On the same day CEERD held the Paristhithy Mithra Award function where green protocol was observed. The function was inaugurated by Dr. Sabu Thomas, Vice-

Chancellor of MG University. This year's awards were presented to Tropical Institute of Ecological Sciences in the institutional category and Sri Sukumaran Nair, secretary of Pampa Parirakshana Samithy in the individual category.4 October 2019 saw the inauguration of the College union by the well-known Malayalam poet, lyricist and journalist Ezhacherry Ramachandran. On 15 October 2019 Sri C.A. Kurian V. John conducted a state-level one-day workshopon Accounting Standards. The Physics Dept. organized an e-waste management workshop by Dr. Shibulal A.L. on 28 November 2019.

As part of its Golden Jubilee Celebrations, the alumni association of the Department of Economics organized a panel discussion consisting of eminent panel lists on 16 December 2019, called "Industrial Investment in Kerala: Opportunities and Challenges". The release of *Bulls Eye Vol.* IX (an in-house publication of the Commerce Department) was on 19 September 2019. The General alumni meeting of the college was held on 22 December 2019 with Sri Mons Joseph MLA as the chief guest. A half-day seminar on *GST Law Registration & Renews* was conducted for all the students of the Commerce Department on 31st December 2019 by Binish T. from the Commerce Academy.

On 1 January 2020 the Campus Radio Talent Hub, under the aegis of the English Dept., was revived. On the same day the department was visited by their 2014-17 Alumni batch who also interacted with the students. On 4 January 2020 CEERD provided training to students in making paper bags, paper pens and cloth mats. The closing ceremony of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations of the Economics Association was held on 3 January 2020 where former Chief Justice of the Madras High Court Dr.K. NarayanaKurupu was the chief guest. The Malayala Samajam conducted an essay competition on the topic *Paristhithi sauhridasusthiravikasananava Keralam entekazhchapadil* on 7 January 2020.

A photo exhibition entitled "Kuttanad Floods" by eminent photographer Kajal Deth was organized by the Photography Club on 10 January 2020. This was to create an awareness about the flood victims as well as make a small donation for the same through the sale of postcards. On 16 January 2020 the students, faculty and non-teaching staff of the college, under the leadership of Smt. Minni Philip, the co-ordinator of the anti-narcotic cell, took a pledge against the use of narcotics. The same day, a career orientation programme was provided for the final year students of the English Dept. by Sri Shaji M. George of Career Launcher on career options.

On 17 January 2020, CEERD organized a field trip for its members to Iravikulam National Park, Munnar. A short film by the Zoology Dept. *Nishantham,* in connection with Bird Club international, was produced and screened at the International Rain Film Festival in Kumarakom on 18 January 2020, attended by five students escorted by faculty member Sri. Biju Thomas.

From 21-22 January 2020 the college arts festival was held with the active participation of all the departments. On 23 January 2020, a food fest named "Uppum Mulakum" was organized by Women's Cell for developing entrepreneurial skills among girl students of the College with more than 40 participants cooking up a variety of items. Commerce Department won the overall championship.

To create awareness, the counselling cell of the college organized an awareness programme on 28 January 2020 by inviting Fr. Sijo Chennadan CMI popularly known as RJ Father to talk to the S6 & S4 students on socio-political & psychological issues of the youth. On that day, "Grow the leader in you" a Leaders Training Program was organized by the Commerce Department for its students. The resource person was Anusha Shanty. 27 leaders from B. Com. and M. Com. participated in the program. The same day, the Physics Dept. conducted an inter-departmental science quiz competition which was organized by the 1st year M.Sc. students.

On January 31 2020, the Mathematics Department held a Mathematics exhibition. The next day they hosted "Mathletics", the inter-collegiate Mathematics fest as well as the Prof. K.M. Joseph Endowment Lecture by Dr. G. Indulal – Associate Professor of St. Aloysius College, Edathua. About 20 participants took part in the fest.

Tibetan poet and activist Tenzin Tsundue conducted an Interactive session with the students of the English Dept on 6 Feb 2020. On 7 February 2020, the English Dept. hosted the inter-collegiate fest "Ignatia 2020" with more than 100 participants from various colleges. The Commerce Fest *La Caza* was held on 15 February 2020. The Physics Department had science day celebrations by conducting an interdepartmental debate competition as well as a sky watch session on 26 February 2020. The Zoology Department gifted each department with a money plant bottle as part of Science Day. On 28 February 2020, the Mathematics Department. conducted an interclass quiz competition.

Building an Academic Climate on the Home Turf : An Orientation to Quality


